


[South Park: Scontri Di-retti presto su Nintendo Switch?](#)

Sanity, secondo rivenditore di musica e video in Australia, ha messo in elenco **South Park: The Fractured But Whole** (in Italia **Scontri Di-retti**) per Nintendo Switch in una lista di prodotti che classificati come "coming soon". Il gioco arriverebbe relativamente presto, il **13 marzo 2018**, al prezzo di 89,99 \$. Al momento non esiste alcuna conferma ufficiale da parte di Ubisoft e di Nintendo una versione del gioco per Switch, ma i rapporti fra le due case hanno portato buoni frutti nell'ultimo anno, a partire da titoli come **Mario+Rabbids: Kingdom Battle**, e l'ipotesi di un accordo non pare affatto assurda. Aggiungiamo, inoltre, il fatto che a una Nintendo Direct Mini segue spesso un **Nintendo Direct** circa 10-15 giorni dopo, potremmo aspettarci un'annuncio di questa puntata.
